



Outdoor Fall Baseball Rules 10U

General

- The goal of the Players Choice of the Fox Cities is to obtain a quality, competitive atmosphere with the focus on the enjoyment of the sport.
- Sportsmanship will be closely monitored.

Playing Rules

- All Little League Rules will be enforced with the following exceptions:
 - All games will be 85 minutes in length or 6 innings, whichever comes first. A new inning may not start after the 75th minute.
 - Coaches are responsible for having their players ready and on and off the field each inning.
 - There will be a 6 run rule per 3 outs. 10 run rule applies after 5 innings.
 - There is a free substitution throughout the game. The idea of this league is to allow players the experience at positions they have signed to play. Pitchers can pitch a maximum of 2 innings per game. NO EXCEPTIONS! Please have your next pitcher ready and warmed up prior to their coming into the game.
 - Infield fly rule will be observed.
 - If a pitcher walks two batters, the third batter will result in an umpire pitching. The umpire will pitch to the batter keeping the same strike count, as strikeouts will be in affect.
 - All players will bat, and the coaches will be asked to have a revolving plan on defense to be fair for all players on their team.
 - The Home Team is responsible for keeping the score. The Umpire is responsible for reporting the final score.
 - There is no stealing of bases. Runners may advance to any base on a passed ball. Runners **may not** advance to home on a passed ball unless the defense makes a play on them.
 - All balls thrown out of play will allow the runner(s) to advance **one base only.**
