



Outdoor Fall Baseball Rules 12U

General

- The goal of the Players Choice of the Fox Cities is to obtain a quality, competitive atmosphere with the focus on the enjoyment of the sport.
- Sportsmanship will be closely monitored.

Playing Rules

- All games are 85 minutes in length or 6 innings, whichever comes first. A new inning may not be started after the 75th minute.
- General Little League Baseball Rules will be observed.
- Pitchers are allowed to pitch 3 innings per game.
- Coaches are responsible for having players on and off the playing field in a timely manner between innings.
- There is a six (6) run rule per three (3) outs. 10 run rule after 5 innings applies.
- All players must be contained within the designated dugout protective screens.
- The Home Team is responsible for keeping the score. The Umpires are responsible for the final score being reported.
- Only roster coaches and players allowed on the field. No parents or spectators.
- Free substitutions on defense. Batting order must remain unchanged. All players can hit if coach desires- 9 players in the field.
- Infield fly rule will be observed.
- No collision rule-must avoid contact if at all possible on sliding and base running situations.
- At least eight players on defense.
- Catchers must wear protective gear (We will have gear on site.)
- Runners can advance to any base, including home, on a pass ball.
- Dead balls are left to the view of the umpires.
- Pitchers are allowed four (4) warm up pitches at the start of an inning.
- All equipment must be kept inside the dugout.

- All final decisions and calls are at the discretion of the Umpires.
