A native of Appleton, he is a 1991 graduate of Appleton West High School. An outfielder and pitcher on the baseball team, Krueger was an All-Fox Valley Association selection and helped the Terrors to the 1991 WIAA state title. He was also a standout for the Appleton Post 38 Legion baseball team that won state championships in 1990 and '91. Korey went on to play at Lawrence University where he was an All-MWC selection in 1993-95 and captain.

Bill Nolan Graduated from Ripon College in 07', finished with a degree in Exercise Science and minor in Health. In baseball I was first team All-conference 04' & 05', all region team 05', was injured before my senior season and started coaching the freshmen while rehabbing. My focus will be on making kids explosive and mechanics of full body throwing. In each lesson your child will warm-up, preferably come ready to pitch. Then we will throw 10-15 pitches and video tape from two different angles. Then we will watch the video and compare to Cy Young winners and MLB's top pitchers. Pitching is a skill that can be learned and with focus on the right parts your child will become a more effective pitcher with more control and confidence.

The left-hander was then selected in the 24th round in the 2001 by the Toronto Blue Jays. In 2003 he was traded to the Minnesota Twins. In 2005 he made his big league debut versus the Cleveland Indians where he received his 1st Major League Win.

Prior to UWM: One of the top starters for Madison Area Technical College as a freshman, posted a 2.74 earned run average while leading the team in innings (61.1) and strikeouts (60) High School: Three-time starter and letterwinner at Appleton North High School, two-time, First-Team All-Fox Valley Association pick, as a senior earned First-Team All-State accolades from the Wisconsin Baseball Coaches Association. named the Region 8 Player of the Year by the WBCA earned Honorable Mention All-Midwest by Baseball America.

Chris Bosio, former Major League pitcher for the Milwaukee Brewers and Seattle Mariners and current Major League pitching coach will be conducting private lessons and hosting large and small group camps and clinics at Players Choice of the Fox Cities. Chris Bosio posted a career 94-93 record, striking out 1,059 batters, posting a 3.96 ERA and throwing a no-hitter on April 22, 1993 (The last no-hitter thrown by a Mariner). After retiring from playing, Bosio began a career in coaching with the Seattle Mariners as their Special Assignment pitching coach, then with the Tampa Bay Devil Rays as their Big League pitching coach, then became the Assistant Coach for pitchers at UW Oshkosh and later Lawrence University before getting back into professional ball for the Cincinnati Reds and their Double-A affiliate the Chattanooga Lookouts. Later, to come back to the Milwaukee Brewers, where he was in their farm system coaching before he spent much of 2009 with the Triple-A Nashville Sounds before replacing Brewers pitching Coach Bill Castro on August 12, 2009.
